Discussion with Don & Dillon

Dillon and Don came and shared updates coming for the upcoming season, with course rating, new pin setup, and new signage

- New scorecards with new rating and white/gold tees
- New pin placement sheets will be placed on all carts
 - All pins will be white with black trim
- New signs at holes 1 & 10 that will outline cart rules (no longer on carts), Pin locations, and Range status
- Handicap groups will be reviewed again in April for how the new course rating shifts groupings
- Gold/white tee selection with league groups discussion will continue in April
 - Likely to be handled in one-off situations
- Yellow Cards
 - Tentative plan: Pro shop and starter will handle the issuance of yellow cards
 - Possible enhancement with Excel sheet to further control distribution and use of yellow cards being explored by Mike Wells & Golf Staff
 - Yellow card/Tuesday scorecard expense is already included in the budget and will be a part of the general scorecard order
